#### Christmas Dinner

This year we will be having our school Christmas dinner on Friday 8<sup>th</sup> December. If your child would like a Christmas dinner, this needs to be ordered on School Spider by 30<sup>th</sup> November. If a Christmas dinner is not ordered, your child will need to bring a packed lunch on this day as there will be no other menu choices available. An order needs to be made for every child who would like a Christmas dinner, regardless of whether they usually have a school dinner or bring a packed lunch. The cost of the meal is £2.95 to be paid through the Tameside council website – Please do not pay if your child is in Rec, Y1 or Y2 as these children are entitled to universal free school meals or if your child is eligible for free school dinners.

#### Nuts:

Please could we remind parents that we are a nut free school. Please ensure you check the ingredients of any food that you are sending in your child's packed lunch & that you don't send anything that contains any kind of nuts or sesame. We have recently had children come to school with pesto, houmous, Nutella & hazelnut croissants. Please check ingredients carefully & leave it for at home if you are not sure.

#### Uniform Price Increase:

Due to increased prices that are being charged by our uniform suppliers, we have had to increase the cost of uniform sweatshirts and cardigans. New prices are given below: Size 24" to 34" sweatshirts £9.80 cardigans £10.60 Size 36" to 38" sweatshirts £11.75 cardigans £12.30

#### Christmas Card orders:


