Gizmobots Junkbot Building Workshop

Junkbot Building Workshops, delivered by Mark Haig of Gizmobots on Wednesday 3 April. 12-3pm. Location: Heigenbottom Room, Ashton Library.

This one-of-a-kind workshop for children aged 7 and up, will see participants using waste electronic equipment to design and create one big junk-bot sculpture together! Mark Haig, founder and Director of <u>Gizmobots</u>, will lead everyone through the process of designing the sculpture, taking apart old electrical items such as hoovers, selecting and assembling parts, and building and embellishing the final piece. Everyone is welcome to bring a bit of their own waste electrical and electronic equipment as well, just make sure it is mainly made of plastic please! We would also recommend coming for the full session, if possible, so you can enjoy the whole creative process! Please be aware, that space is limited - No need to book in advance.
