



Sports Premium Planned Expenditure 2022-23

Our vision for PE and school sport is to create a culture that encourages all children to be active and healthy. We aim to promote positive attitudes towards competition, physical activity and healthy lifestyles.

For the financial year April 2022- March 2023 Livingstone Primary School has received £17,690 to improve the quality of PE and sport. We also have a carry forward of £7500. This makes a total spend available of £25,190

This funding will help develop a programme to include:

- High quality PE lessons
- Extra-curricular sports clubs
- Greater outdoor provision for all children in the school
- Mental health support for all children as needed
- CPD opportunities for staff
- Top up swimming lessons for those that have not achieved the national curriculum expectations.

This report follows the financial rather than the academic year.

Tameside Active Coach	Highly skilled coach to teach all classes in school across a day.	£6000	We invest in a sports coach who teaches in our school one day per week to provide an enhanced sports provision programme. This ensures that a large majority of our pupils are exposed to high quality coaching every week. Over the course of the year, they will receive coaching in a range of sports and games
After school sports club until 5pm	Sports club to run on weekly basis throughout the academic year.		The sports club will give more children the chance to receive high quality coaching in a number of different sports and games. They will build on the skills learned in curriculum PE lessons and will be given the opportunity to practice them in more competitive situations. Many children will be given the opportunity to be introduced to sports that would not ordinarily have the chance to play. The sports club will build confidence and self-esteem in many of the children who attend.

Monitoring and School Games criteria and Ofsted criteria.	£1500	A proportion of the £1500 for Tameside School Sports Partnership includes professional development opportunities for teachers. This will include Subject Leader PLT days to keep our school informed of and address current PE issues. The support will also include the subject leader and other teachers working alongside qualified sports coaches. Being a member of the Tameside Sports Partnership also gives children the opportunity to take part in competitive inter school sports. This will give the children experience of using the skills that they learn in PE lessons in a match situation and allow them to further develop their

			skills. It will also provide them with the opportunity to challenge themselves, work as a team and represent the school at a local level.
Resources to enhance gross motor skills in EYFS	Replenish pedal bikes, balance bikes and helmets to enable more children to take part in Little bikers activities in EYFS	£2500	Having more fully functioning bikes will help develop the children's gross motor skills develop at a quicker rate. Children will be encouraged to be more active and begin to develop balance and coordination skills more quickly.
Resources to enhance the provision of curriculum time PE lessons	Purchase variety of resources for both KS1 and KS2 to enable teachers to continue to deliver high quality PE lessons	£600	Having high quality resources will enhance the lessons taught by coaches and teachers. Children will have a more positive experience of PE and sport and with a higher number of resources will spend more time in lessons practising the skills. The standard of PE lessons will be driven up by this.
Additional Top-up swimming for Y6 children who haven't met the National Curriculum KS2 standard + transport	Children assessed and those who have not met the standard are given opportunity to receive extra swimming lessons in curriculum time.	£2000	We offer further curriculum time swimming lessons in the Spring term for any children who, after attending school swimming lessons, have still not yet reached the National Curriculum swimming standard. This will allow more children the opportunity to reach the required standard and increase children's confidence in the water.
Improved and robust storage for PE equipment and resources	Storage to keep PE equipment and resources safely locked away. Having a robust and hardwearing space for the storage of PE equipment will have the impact of improving the ease of use of equipment and result in higher quality lessons.	£1000	PE resources and equipment will be safely stored and more easily accessible for staff. This will mean that more resources are more regularly used. Equipment will be better looked after and will last for longer. Quality of PE provision will therefore be increased.
Playground Equipment	A range of equipment to support active playtimes and to encourage children to be physically active for sustained periods through the day.	£300	Children are able to engage in more active playtimes and are encouraged to lead a more active lifestyle.
Sports Kit for competitions	Purchase school branded sports kit in various sizes that can be worn for a variety of different sports and events.	£400	Children will benefit from the feeling of unity, team cohesiveness and make children feel that they belong. Each member of the team will feel equally valued and important.
Insurance	Insurance costs for teachers to transport pupils to competitions.	£250	All staff being able to transport pupils to competitions will mean that more children will be able to take part and the school will be able to enter a greater number of competitions.
Forest School	Minor improvements made to forest school provision	£300	Ensuring that the forest school area remains in a good condition ensures that it can have a positive impact on the development of a large number of pupils. It can help improve concentration and motivation to learn. It also allows children to gain more independence and self-confidence.
Outdoor Education Trip	Approximately one third of the cost of an outdoor and adventurous residential trip will be covered by sports premium. It will also cover the cost of 5 children who are in receipt of pupil premium.	£3500	Children will be immersed in outdoor education activities. They will be introduced to many new sports and activities such as archery, canoeing, caving and rock climbing. By covering some of the cost a greater number of pupils will be able to benefit from the experience.
Additional after school clubs	High quality clubs run by a specialist professional company will allow children the opportunity to have greater sporting experiences.	£2200	The sports club will give more children the chance to receive high quality coaching in a number of different sports and games. They will build on the skills learned in curriculum PE lessons and will be given the opportunity to practice them in more competitive situations. Many children will be given the opportunity to be introduced to sports that would not ordinarily have the chance to play. The sports club will build confidence and self-esteem in many of the children who attend.

Scheme for teachers planning	Purchase of a scheme to ensure that teachers have the planning that will lead to higher quality delivery of PE lessons.	£600	All PE lessons will be of a greater quality and the development of skills will be more graduated. Gymnastics and dance lessons, in particular, will see a benefit with an increased focus on the development, rehearsal and then application of movements.
Extra swimming for year 4	Giving children the opportunity to start swimming lessons earlier will allow more time for pupils to achieve the expected standard by the time they leave Year 6.	£2000	Additional swimming in the Summer term for Year 4 pupils to prepare them for the following year's swimming lessons will give an increased number of children a greater opportunity to reach the National Standard for Key Stage 2 children.

We believe that the spending of our Sports Premium grant is sustainable because:

- The sports coach will provide children with the skills that can be transferred to a range of sports and activities that can be used throughout their lives.
- After school provision will enable more children to take in competitive sport, giving them a greater understanding of teamwork, drive and belonging that they can apply to various aspects of their future lives.
- Being a member of Tameside Sports Partnership will enable the PE lead to gain valuable knowledge and skills to move the subject forward and implement a strong PE culture for years to come.
- The 'top-up' swimming sessions will help to give the children the life-long skill of being a competent swimmer and being confident in the water. They will be more aware of water safety.
- Mental health support is able to be given early on to support children and families as and when they need it.
- Sports week gives children the opportunity to experience different sports which they may then choose to pursue outside of school.
- The Mini Bikers programme will help develop the children's co-ordination and balance.
