#### **Reception Applications:**

#### WOW (Walk Once a Week):

We have now started a campaign to encourage children and their parents to walk to school. Children will self-register at the start of the day how they have travelled to school. For this option, the description is that they have walked for at least 10 minutes which would be from the Market Ground or from the Gillery depending on direction of travel.
